<p><b>Program Update</b></p>	<p>Courtney Moyett, Tobacco Prevention Specialist, gave an update of the programs activities for quarter three focusing on each policy area. Courtney also discussed some events that the partnership participated in during Quarter 3. The partnership had a booth at the PAC Meeting, Health and Safety Expo, presented at the Kiwanis Club of Okeechobee and presented at the Okeechobee County Chamber of Commerce Quarterly Luncheon. Paula Smith gave an overview of the School Health Advisory Committee and its role in the partnership and in particular the K-12 school policy. The SHAC committee meets every month and the TPS attends each meeting. The SHAC has played an important role in influencing the school administration to implement a tobacco free policy for Okeechobee County Schools. Sharon Vinson with the Shared Services Network gave a recap on the Health and Safety Expo that was held in January 2014, 130 booths participated in the event and over 2200 people in attendance. The partnership sponsored this event and had a booth as well as the local SWAT chapter.
